

LCEC: Getting Annual Consumption


 Once on home page navigate to the "MY HOME" Tab, and from the dropdown click on "SmartHub Login"



2. Once logged in you should see a page that looks like this



3. Click on the "My Usage" tab and you'll be shown this (below) Click on the "Usage Explorer tool"



4. You will be greeted by a page that looks like this




5. By default it should have a "Monthly" view, a "Date Range" of the current month to 12 months prior (the example shown has a Date Range from August 2022 to August 2023), and the "Usage" option should be selected if it isn't already.


6. If you scroll down you will see this graph of the previous 12 months (In this example, this home had a meter swapped at the end of May: which is shown in orange, prior to the swap it shows the other meter's readings in Green)



7. The total Usage is found in the table labeled "Usage." (In the instance of a meter swap you will see a drop down to select a specific meter)



8. If only one meter then your total usage is shown at the bottom of the table (above)



9. If there is a second meter (shown above) you will need to add the first meter total with the newest meter's readings. Simply click the drop down and select the other meter number, and add the total usage together to get a grand total for the previous 12 months. (For this example, the first meter read 19,585 kW, and the second meter read 11,270 kW. So about 30,855 kW are being consumed yearly.
